



COLLEGE SOCCER RECRUITING | CONTACT RULES

NCAA DIVISION I

RECRUITING METHOD	
Recruiting Materials and Electronic Correspondence (e.g., recruiting letters, emails, social media messages, text messages)	<p>You may receive brochures for camps, questionnaires, NCAA material and non-athletic recruiting publications at any time.</p> <p>A coach may begin sending you recruiting materials and electronic correspondence June 15th between your sophomore and junior year in high school.</p>
Phone Calls to a Coach	<p>You or your family may call a coach beginning of June 15th between your sophomore and junior year in high school.</p>
Phone Calls from a Coach	<p>A coach may call you or your family beginning June 15th between your sophomore and junior year of high school.</p>
Off-campus Contact	<p>A college coach may have contact with you or your family off the college's campus beginning Aug. 1st of your junior year in high school.</p>
Unofficial Visits	<p>You and your family may visit a college at your own expense beginning Aug. 1st of your junior year in high school.</p>
Official Visits	<p>A college may pay for you to visit the college beginning Aug. 1st of your junior year in high school. There is no limit to the number of official visits. You are limited to one official visit per school (unless there is a coaching change after your first visit).</p>

NCAA DIVISION II & III

RECRUITING METHOD	DIVISION II	DIVISION III
Recruiting Materials	<p>You may receive brochures for camps, questionnaires, NCAA material and nonathletic recruiting publications at any time.</p> <p>A coach may begin sending you printed recruiting material June 15th immediately preceding your junior year in high school.</p>	<p>You may receive printed materials any time.</p>
Telephone Calls	<p>No limit on number of calls by college coach beginning June 15th immediately preceding your junior year.</p> <p>You may make calls to the coach at your own expense.</p>	<p>No limit on number of calls or when they can be made by the college coach.</p> <p>You may make calls to the coach at your own expense.</p>
Off-campus Contact	<p>A college coach may have contact with you or your parents/legal guardians off the college's campus beginning June 15th immediately preceding your junior year.</p> <p>No limit on number of contacts off campus.</p>	<p>A college coach may have contact with you or your relatives or guardians off the college's campus after your sophomore year.</p> <p>No limit on number of contacts off campus.</p>
Unofficial Visit	<p>You may make an unlimited number of unofficial visits any time, except during a dead period.</p>	<p>You may make an unlimited number of unofficial visits any time.</p>
Official Visit	<p>A college may pay for you to visit the college beginning June 15th immediately preceding your junior year.</p> <p>Between June 15th before your junior year and the end of your senior year in high school, you may make only one official visit per college (unless there is a coaching change after your first visit). There is no limit to official visits to Division II colleges.</p>	<p>A college may pay for you to visit the college beginning Jan. 1st of your junior year in high school.</p> <p>There is no limit to official visits to Division III colleges. However, you may only be provided one visit per college (unless there is a coaching change after your first visit).</p>

NAIA: The NAIA does not regulate the contact between a coach and a current high school athlete. Keep in mind that the national office does not recognize a Letter of Intent, but a school or conference might as a part of their rules.
