



Eugene Metro FC Uniform Policy

EMFC strives to maintain a professional image. The club uniform plays an integral part in forging a club identity and in building both a sense of community and of pride in the organization. This club identity can only be accomplished if all EMFC teams wear the designated club uniform so that no matter what the age group, no matter what the occasion, the team can be readily identified as representing the Eugene Metro Fútbol Club.

adidas is the exclusive sponsor (excluding shoes) for all Eugene Metro FC Programs. The uniform lifespan is estimated to be two years. At the end of the 2-year period, new uniforms will again be a required purchase. Players are required to wear the most current version of our uniform to games. Players not adhering to these requirements may not be able to participate in games.

- All EMFC players and coaching staff must wear adidas gear on game day. **Exception:** players may wear footwear, shin guards, and compression/under tops/shorts from a different vendor.
- Teams may also use the EMFC uniforms for tournaments, indoor leagues and various other small-sided or extra tournaments as long as the team is registered as a EMFC team. A EMFC team playing in an event where they are not identified as a EMFC team (i.e. Roadrunners, etc.) may not wear the EMFC uniform.
- The official EMFC uniform supplier is Tursi. All EMFC teams must purchase uniforms through Tursi soccer store. EMFC will coordinate uniform numbers and families will purchase uniforms through Tursi.

Game Day Uniform Requirements:

- Grey Uniform - grey jersey, grey shorts and grey socks with white stripes (Home game uniform)
- Blue Uniform - blue jersey, blue shorts and blue socks with white stripes (Away game uniform)
- Long Sleeve Shirts worn under jersey must match the jersey color

Exceptions to the above should be rare but may include:

- The home team is required to change kits in the event of a conflict
- A large portion of kids on the team forgot their jersey (should only happen once!)
- In an effort to gain a competitive advantage in hot weather, team wears grey instead of blue.

EMFC Number Policy on jerseys

EMFC players often get opportunities to play on other EMFC teams for the following reasons:

- A team is short and will ask a guest player from another EMFC team.
- Player development opportunities
- Other conflicts that require guest players

In order to ensure that players in the same age group can easily guest play with each other and there are no number conflicts the club assigns numbers ranges to each team.

Training/ Practice Gear–required to wear to all practices

- short sleeve grey EMFC training jersey
- Black Shorts
- Black Socks

Coaches often make smaller teams and in order to identify teams easier, it helps when all players wear the same shirt. If the weather gets colder and wetter, we recommend the following layers that can be taken off during practice:

- Long adidas pants over shorts
- Long sleeve EMFC training top over short sleeve
- Light rain or wind breaker
- Beanie and gloves if it is really cold

Sponsorship logos may NOT be displayed on the uniform kit (shorts, jerseys, socks). Sponsorship logos must first be approved by the EMFC Director before imprinting on any team gear also bearing the EMFC logo.

Names on uniforms are not permitted.

Goalkeeper Uniforms

- adidas EMFC GK jersey
- Numbers 0,1,00
- Black Shorts
- Black Socks

Non-adidas gear

- Goalkeeper can wear different brand GK gloves
- Players can wear any brand soccer shoes
- Players need to bring a soccer ball to practice.

Eugene Metro FC is an adidas sponsored club and the club is obligated to reflect the adidas brand at all times.
